The Commission for Motion Laboratory Accreditation (CMLA) has no jurisdiction and no policy related to whether motion laboratories within the same hospital network may share application materials. If sharing occurs, the following apply:

1. Applicants declare that materials within the application contain shared content. They sign an affidavit that any shared content has occurred within the same hospital network and not with affiliated institutions outside their network or completely unaffiliated institutions.
2. Each application will be assessed on an individual basis, and, therefore, application materials that have been approved for one lab may not be approved for another lab within the same hospital network.
3. If sections are shared between labs, they should be specifically identified in the application including the institution from which the documents and materials came.
4. Everything included in the accreditation application should reflect the actual practices performed in the applicant's laboratory. Common practices will be labeled as such.
5. Application comments from the CMLA apply only to the individual lab that received them, and cannot be generalized to all labs within the system.
